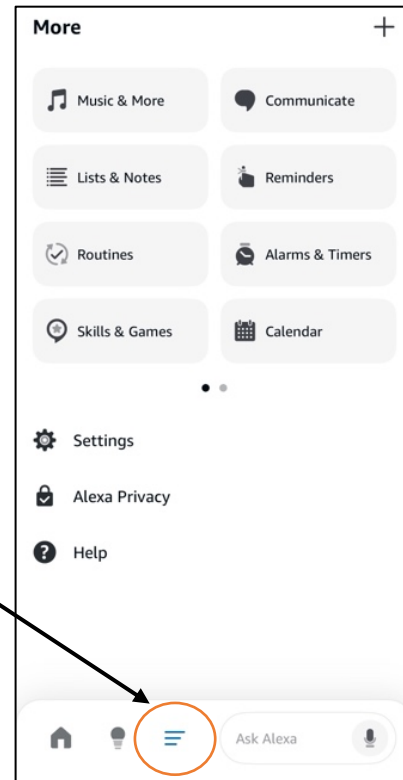

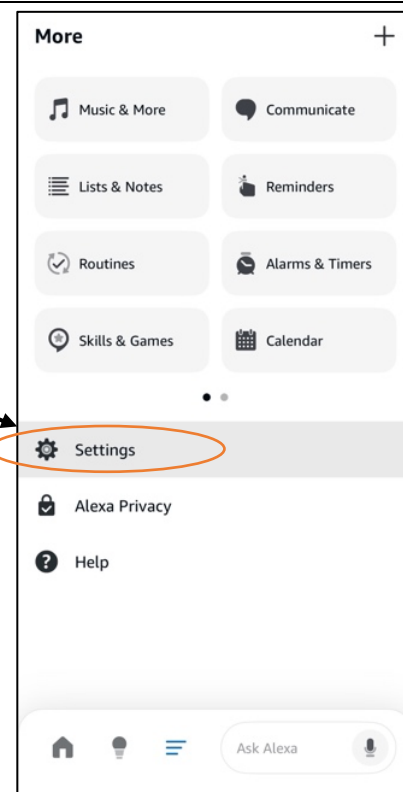
## Step by Step Instructions with App Navigation

2. Tap **More** (≡) at the bottom right.

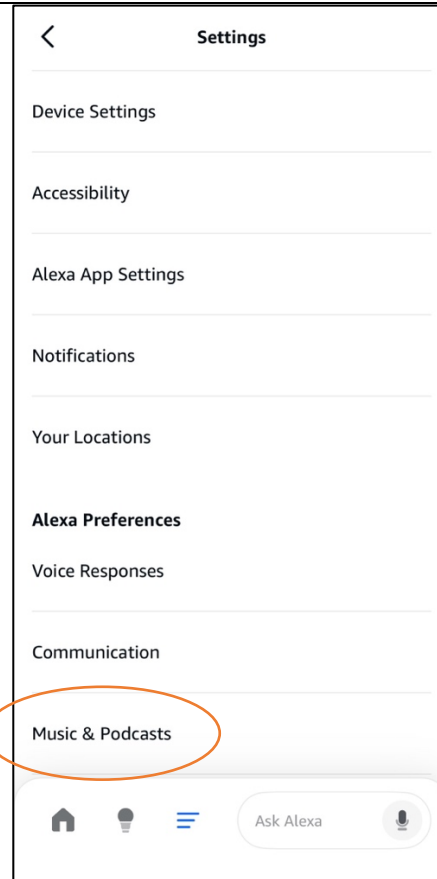
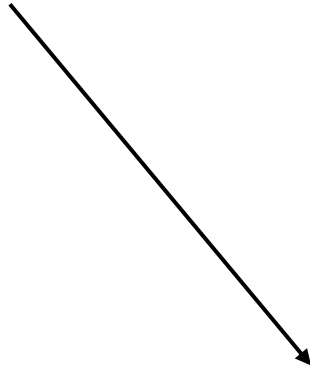


3. Tap **Settings**.

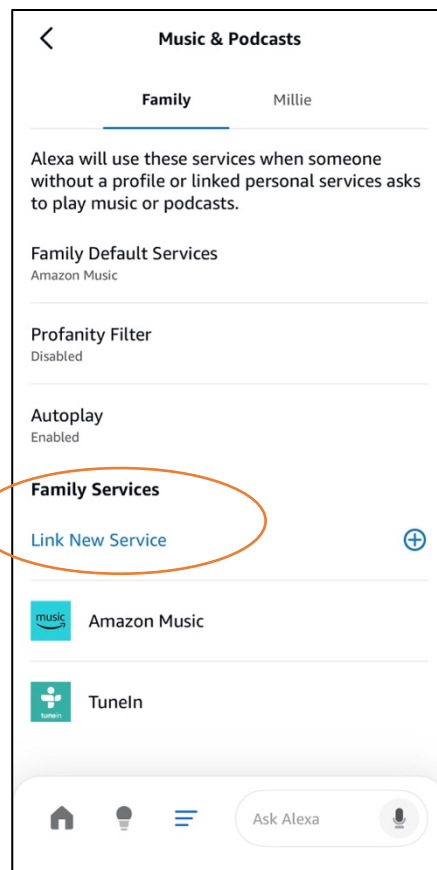
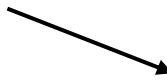

4. Tap Music & Podcasts.

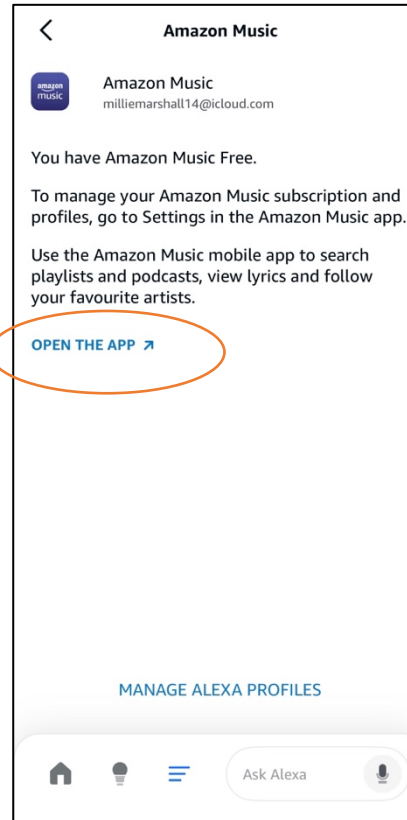


5. Under Family Services, Tap Link New Service

9. Tap **Connected to**, to change or see which device your account is connected to.

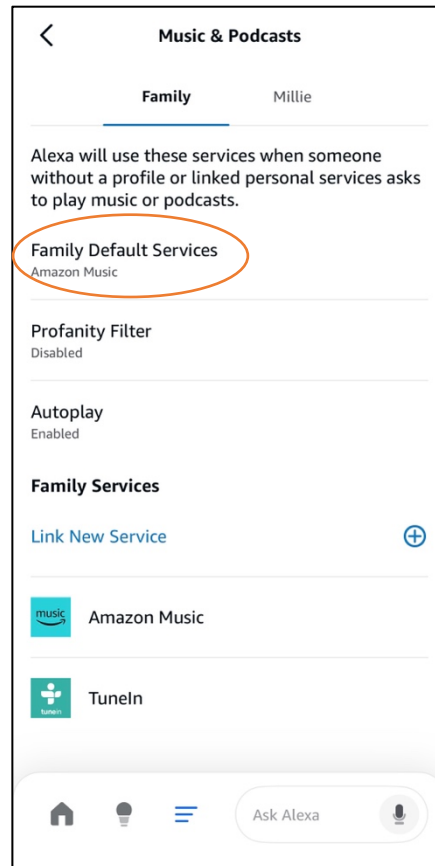
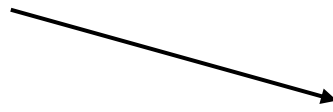
### 10. Go Back to your Amazon App

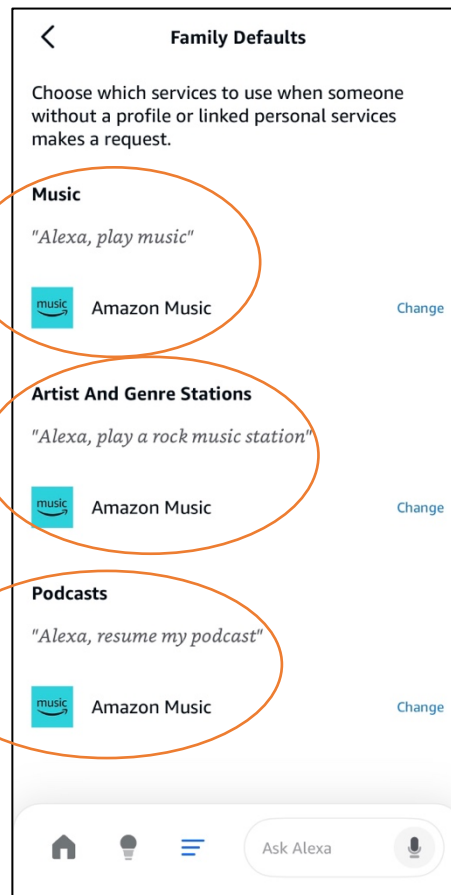
## 12. Tap family Default Services
